





Vocabulary

- Transaction A record of income or expense
- Books A ledger of accounts, including all transactions
 - Most commonly checkbook register, or financial software
- **Reconciling** Is the process of making sure one record of a financial account is consistent with another.
 - 1. Compare receipts/invoices/deposit slips to bank statements
 - 2. Compare "books" to bank statements
 - 3. If discrepancies exist, make corrections or contact financial institution. File a reconciliation worksheet identifying uncleared checks or unposted deposits.




What does "doing the books" mean?

- Collecting receipts, invoices and other financial documentation
- Balancing the checkbook
- Entering transactions into a software system ("books"), reconciling regularly, classifying transactions by tax line

- At minimum you must download software




QuickBooks Online v. Quicken

QuickBooks Online

- \$30 \$200 per month, depending on Plan Selection
 - Recommend "QuickBooks Essentials". Regularly \$55 per month.
- Business accounting software, built to track income, expenses, inventory, and accounts payable

Quicken

- \$4 \$10 per month, depending on plan selection
 - Recommend "Quicken Deluxe" Regularly \$5 per month
- Personal accounting software, built to track income, and expenses



Why pick one over the other?

QuickBooks Online

- Advantages
 - Preferred software of accountants
 - Invoicing, payroll, detailed inventory tracking
 - Remote access for bookkeeper/accountant
- Disadvantages
 - Cost
 - · Ease of use
 - · No "offline" entry

Quicken Deluxe

- Advantages
 - More user friendly
 - Transactions can be entered offline (data file stored locally)
 - Affordable
- Disadvantages
 - No invoicing or payroll*
 - Not online/cloud-based system no remote access unless synced
 - Cannot convert from Quicken to QuickBooks anymore
 - No inventory tracking

Software Specific Vocabulary

QuickBooks Online

- QBO QuickBooks Online
- Gear icon icons at top right of QuickBooks Online. The gear icon is where all operational features reside. From here you can access Manage Users, Accounts and Settings, Attachments, Recurring Transactions, Budget, User Profiles and more.
- Chart of accounts complete listing of each account in a business's accounting system.
- Invoice when you sell to a customer who will pay you later.
- Bill when you purchase a product or service from a vendor, and you will pay them later.

Quicken Deluxe

- Category Associates each transaction with a tax-line
 - FOR THE IRS
- Tag Another way of organizing/classifying transactions, not associated with tax lines
 - FOR YOU
- Account Collection of Transactions
- File Group of accounts (cash, checking, operating loan, mortgage)
 - Only include accounts that funds can transfer between.. i.e. Farm Checking and Farm Credit Card
 - Do not include accounts in a file that should not transfer – i.e. the Church accounts with the ranch accounts.

 - Subscription Options:
 - Self-Employed NO
 - Simple Start \$30/month
 - Essentials \$55/month
 - Plus \$85/month
 - Essentials \$200/month
- Flexibility customize for your business
